History Bits



Storm cellars, such as this one still found at Carney and Larry Drives., mushroomed beside houses in Garland and the surrounding area after the cyclone struck on May 9, 1927, killing 14 and injuring many more. But some preferred their chances above ground over the thought of whatever crawled beneath it.



The Daniel Bechtol home, built in the 1890s, anchored 310 acres fronting on the south side of present Kingsley Road between Duck Creek and Saturn Road. As with many houses of that day, rain water was captured from gutters on the house for storage in a cistern. This supplemented what the family could pump from a well.
