Why are these important to you? Orchard Hills has a rich history in its residents. Many started out as returning military from WWII or Korea. Others were starting families after college on the GI Bill. We included skilled workers or managers from the many manufacturers or other businesses which came to Garland in the boom of the 50's. These folks hold a vast storehouse of knowledge on the beginnings and past of our neighborhood. The neighborhood association and its leaders are important factors in the quality of life in your neighborhood. This not only affects your quality of life, but also affects the value of your property. Local government has the most direct impact on you of any level of government and you can influence it more than any other level of government. You say "I don't have kids in the schools. How can they affect me?" The quality of your local schools is one of the greatest factors in the value of your home or business. Good schools produce a quality workforce for business. Effective schools reduce crime. (It costs 3 times as much to send someone to prison for four years than it does to send them to college.) Your city council decides the funding for roads (potholes), police and fire protection, water and sewer service, garbage collection, and, for many of us, electric service. All of these folks are elected in a nonpartisan election held in May. There are no long lines and no party lines. These folks will (usually) actually listen to you and vote accordingly. You can drop them an email, corner them in the grocery store, or even attend their meetings. If you think your vote doesn't count, think of this. Last year a local election in Garland was decided by 12 votes. Our roots go deep. At our Annual Meeting, you can meet with long-time residents, leaders of the Association, and local candidates and office holders. For all these reasons and more....come on out on April 14th at 6:30 pm for our Annual Meeting!


